



Artmap Argyll is a social enterprise company that formed as a membership network of artists.

Our Vision is for Artmap Argyll to be nationally recognised as a vibrant network of Argyll Artists that celebrate and promote the art created in Argyll, sharing skills and collaborating to make art accessible to all.

Artmap Argyll Aims to:

Support Artists to **Make** and promote art that is created in Argyll.

Engage wider audiences in art activities through Open Studios, workshops, events and bespoke projects.

Connect the artists of Argyll with each other through our network, and with people who are interested in art and creativity.

Our Objectives are to:

1. Provide opportunities for artists to exhibit, tutor and sell their work from an Argyll base
2. Increase access to arts based experiences and learning opportunities for the communities of Argyll, particularly young people
3. Facilitate networking, collaboration and partnership projects
4. Raise awareness of Artmap Argyll's work across a wider geographic area
5. Become more financially sustainable with a part time paid resource in place.

Membership Criteria

Full Membership is open to any practising artist in Argyll & Bute who supports the objectives of the group and who meet **at least four** of the following:

- 1) Active involvement in professional development and visual arts practice
- 2) Exhibition history, such as galleries, trade shows & museums
- 3) Publications such as reviews, articles, catalogues or leaflets
- 4) Art training - specify name of college, courses, dates, qualifications
- 5) Related professional experience - such as any art teaching, arts consultancy, design and marketing experience
- 6) List any relevant awards, scholarships or grants
- 7) Commissions
- 8) Works represented in public collections

Full Members are also able to take part in the annual Open Studio event. There is an additional fee of £120 for this that covers the cost of producing the directory and promotion for the event.

Associate Membership is open to anyone who is interested in supporting, promoting and championing the work and objectives of Artmap Argyll.

Associate members will receive emails or newsletters with information and invitations to workshops, events, to projects and to general committee meetings or social gatherings.

There is an opportunity to exhibit artwork in the annual exhibition at The Dochas Gallery during the Open Studios Event. The exhibition is organised collectively by associate members and is a numbered Red Dot venue in the Artmap directory. Other venues may participate.

Friends of Artmap are individuals who are not artists or aspiring artists who wish to support the work of Artmap Argyll

Next Stage

The voluntary membership committee using the criteria guidelines above for decision-making reviews applications for full artist membership.

We aim to inform applicants of the committee's decision within 28 days. If successful you will be sent an Artmap Argyll welcome pack and entered on Artmap Argyll's full membership register.

Unsuccessful applicants will receive feedback and an invitation to join as an associate member along with membership benefits.
